USDA Zones 3 through 8



The extensive green roof plants listed below are proven to be reliable and low maintenance within USDA zones 3 through 8 using the GreenGrid system. We suggest using approximately 50% evergreen plantings to assure year-round interest and plant coverage. A mix of 6-9 of the varieties listed are typically used, and not all plant species listed will be present. The plants designated with an asterisk (*) should be included. Please refer to the GreenGrid® Green Roof Maintenance Guide for plant maintenance requirements.
