

Southeastern U.S. Plants

Semi-Intensive or Intensive Depths



Selection of green roof plants in the southeastern U.S. region can vary throughout the region and should be customized for the application and site conditions. A minimum of 6-inches of substrate is recommended along with permanent irrigation. Please refer to the GreenGrid® Green Roof Maintenance Guide for plant maintenance requirements.

Regional Plantings should include:

- Delosperma (multiple varieties)
- Sedum mexicanum
- Perennial Peanut (FL area – monoculture in lieu of sedum)
- Talinum Calycinum



Standard Plantings may include:

- Sedum album (mixed varieties)
- Sedum sexangulare
- Sedum spurium 'John Creech'
- Sedum spurium 'Summer Glory'
- Sedum 'Weihenstephaner Gold'
- Sedum spurium 'Fuldaglut'

- Sedum middendorffianum
- Sedum immergrunchen
- Sedum takeimensiensies 'Golden Carpet'
- Sedum reflexum 'Blue Spruce'
